


A Kingdom Arrows Study

Week One ~ Discussion


Welcome to week one of our study of John. This week we will read through John 1 and 2. Here, Jesus calls His first disciples and performs His first miracle. We will be answering the key question, **What does it look like to become a disciple of Jesus?**

5. (John 2:1-12) There is a lot we could look at in studying Jesus's first miracle, including how He listened to His mother. However, today we are going to look at the impact this miracle had on the disciples. Look specifically at verse 11. Why was it important that the disciples saw Jesus perform a miracle? What has Jesus done in your life that has made you believe that Jesus is who He says He is?
4. (John 2:13-25) As Jesus cleanses the temple, there is something important that happens for the disciples. First, they see Jesus fulfilling prophesies from scripture (vs 17). But they also hear scripture being foretold (vs 19). Because of these events, the disciples believed that scripture was the true, spoken word of God. Why is it important for a disciple of Jesus to believe that the all of the Bible is true?



KEY QUESTION: What does it mean to become a disciple of Jesus?

Becoming men of prayer...



To close out your discussion time, take a moment to pray for the men in your group. Ask God to continue to teach you how to become a man of action as you learn to be a follower of Christ. You can have one person pray for the whole group or take turns praying for each other. (i.e James prays for Noah, Noah prays for Ethan, Ethan prays for Richard, Richard prays for James)
