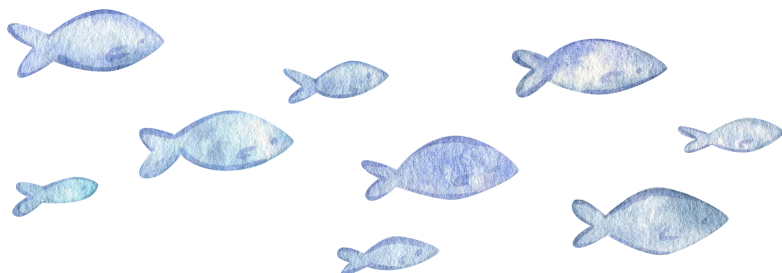
# Welcome!

# Week One ~ Discussion

Welcome to week one of our study of John. This week we will read through John 1 and 2. Here, Jesus calls His first disciples and performs His first miracle. We will be answering the key question, ***What does it look like to become a disciple of Jesus?***

1. **(John 1:19-34)** John the Baptist knew that God's purpose for him was to prepare the way for Christ's ministry. Throughout scripture we see evidence of him not pointing to himself, but to Jesus. **What can we learn from John leading people to Christ?**

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2. **(John 1:35-51)** As we look at the calling of the disciples, we see that they were men of action. They weren't just at home hoping they would be invited while they sat on the couch. No! They were SEEKING Jesus, and that's why they were with John the Baptist. When Jesus called them to come with Him, they didn't say "maybe later Jesus." They FOLLOWED Him. Additionally, when they learned about Jesus, they didn't just keep it to themselves and do the bare minimum. They went and INVITED their friends to follow Jesus as well. **After studying these verses, ask yourself these questions. Are you willing to be a man of action as a disciple of Jesus? Are you willing to invite others alongside you to hold you accountable?**

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3. **(John 2:1-12)** There is a lot we could look at in studying Jesus's first miracle, including how He listened to His mother. However, today we are going to look at the impact this miracle had on the disciples. Look specifically at verse 11. **Why was it important that the disciples saw Jesus perform a miracle? What has Jesus done in your life that has made you believe that Jesus is who He says He is?**

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4. **(John 2:13-25)** As Jesus cleanses the temple, there is something important that happens for the disciples. First, they see Jesus fulfilling prophecies from scripture (vs 17). But they also hear scripture being foretold (vs 19). Because of these events, the disciples believed that scripture was the true, spoken word of God. **Why is it important for a disciple of Jesus to believe that the all of the Bible is true?**

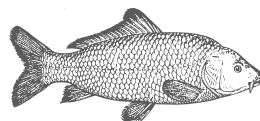
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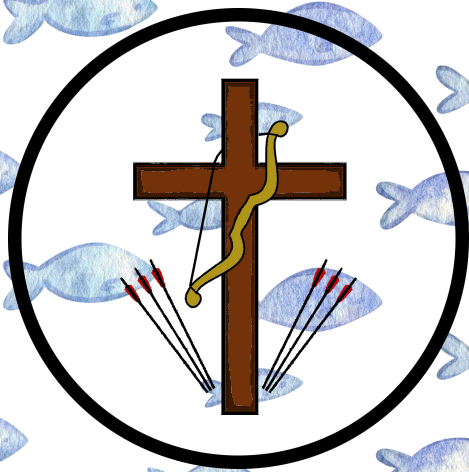
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✿ **KEY QUESTION:** *What does it mean to become a disciple of Jesus?*
