* START BY OPENING UP IN PRAYER, ASKING GOD TO ELIMINATE DISTRACTIONS AND HELP US TO HEAR WHAT HE HAS TO TEACH US DURING THIS TIME

IF YOUR BIBLE HAS A CONCORDANCE, GO TO IT AND LOOK FOR THE WORD JOY. IF YOUR BIBLE DOES NOT HAVE A CONCORDANCE, USE THE LIST OF VERSES LISTED BELOW. SPLIT THE VERSES UP BETWEEN FAMILY MEMBERS. HAVE EACH PERSON TAKE NOTES ON WHAT THAT VERSE SAYS ABOUT JOY. DON'T FORGET THAT SOMETIMES IT HELPS TO READ PART OF THE WHOLE PASSAGE TO GAIN CONTEXT.
